Meet Conditions:

1. This meet is open to all financial SNZ registered competitive or club swimmers .
 2. Meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA rules.
 3. Age as at 15 October 2017.
 4. Self-marshalling will operate throughout the meet.
 5. This event will be swum short course.
 6. During warmup, lanes 0-9 will be for general swimming with no diving for the first 20mins, after which lanes 0, 1, 8, 9 will become sprint lanes with diving, **EXCEPT**, if required, Lane 0 will be reserved for Para swimmers only throughout the warmup.
 7. Swimmers may enter 3 individual events (plus skins and 1 relay), swimmers cannot enter 4 individual events. **No Times** will be accepted. All events will be swum as timed finals. Relay entries to be completed by the Club Administrator.
 8. Entry fees \$20 meet fee per swimmer for 1-3 individual events (excluding the skins). Entries and payment will be via the SNZ Database.
 9. **Skins**
If you want to swim in the skins enter the event and the fastest 10 male and female 100 IM times will qualify to swim.
Swimmers lanes selected in a draw. Will be swum as 25m, every 45 seconds and the last swimmer is eliminated. The stroke for each 25m is drawn by the Referee. The final 2 swimmers vie for a prize.
 10. Entries open on 20 September 2017 and close at **midnight (11:59:59)** on
11. There will be no refunds for withdrawals once psych sheets are released on Tuesday 10 October 2017

 14. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under the IPC swimming rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Referee at the commencement of the meet.
 15. **By entering this meet, swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swim Wellington in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.**
 16. All clubs must undertake the Duty Club positions as listed below.
 17. Swimming Wellington reserves the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme.
 18. Swimming Wellington will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet.
 19. Participating Clubs are to provide officials as requested by RTOP over and above the Duty Club requirements.
