2017 Signature Meet Conditions

- This event will be swum Short Course and the start end will be from the deep end. Please note the pool depth is 1.2m – 2m. Care is required when diving. Entry to the pool during warm-up will be feet first only (except authorised sprint lanes).
- The meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA rules, with over the top starts.
- There will be no self-marshalling at this meet.
- A Team Managers' meeting will be held 10 minutes prior the start of the meet
- Age is at 22 July 2017. Open to SNZ registered competitive swimmers, apart from club events 3, 4, 12, 16, 17 & 25 which are open to SNZ registered "club swimmers" only. Heats for club events will be capped to the top 14 swimmers in each and ribbons will be awarded.
- Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and must present their classification card to the Meet Director/Referee prior to the commencement of the meet.
- Entries are restricted to 3 events per swimmer per session
- Racing ages: 10 & U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17+
- Medals will be awarded to the first three place-getters in these age groups. 4th-7th places will receive a ribbon. There will be medal presentations after events 8, 21, & 34 and at the end of each session. A same gender representative may stand in to collect a medal if the recipient is unavailable.
- Event 39 & 40: Champion of Champions (7 fastest swimmers from Events 33 & 34 compete). A trophy is awarded to the first competitive Wairarapa swimmer in each event. (If a swimmer from outside the region wins, they shall be awarded a medal for 1st place).
- Points allocations:
10 & U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16 17+ (50s & 100s)
12 & Under, 13 & Over (200s & 400s)
- Points: 20, 14, 10, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 (1-10 placings) per meet. Clubs scoring highest points on the night will be noted and the trophy will go to the club with the highest points in January annually.
- Participating clubs can earn additional points through Club support of each Signature Meet. 4-12 swimmers = 10 Points; 13-20 swimmers = 15 Points; 20-30 Swimmers = 20 Points; 31+ swimmers = 25 Points
- Maximum session length 3.5 hours – includes 25min warm up.
- Entries will be via the SNZ Database. Entries close at 23:59.59 (midnight) on Friday 14th July.
- Entry fees are \$10 per event, payment online by credit card.
- There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the entries close on Friday 14th July 2017.
- All scratchings will close by midday on Friday 21st July.
- 1 NT per session for 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m or 1500m events. No NTs for 50m events.
- There is no GST component to entry fees for this meet.
- Swimming Wellington pool entry passes are to be used by Officials, Swimmers, Coaches and Team Managers. Entry and programmes for nominated Team Coaches & Team Managers will be; 1-10 Swimmers [2], 11-20 [4], 21-35+ [6].
- Entry to the Trust House Recreation Centre is via the Main Entrance. Please ensure you show your pass upon entry.
- \$2 door entry fee must be paid by all spectators. Entry through the main entrance for all spectators. Programmes, \$2 per session
- The organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the sport's anti-doping rules.
- The organisers reserve the right to amend the programme if necessary, and to restrict entries
- Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swimming Wellington or host club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
