MEET CONDITIONS

1. Meet will be swum under SNZ /FINA rules
2. **The Championships are open to all financial members of your Club who are included in the SNZ Database**
3. Age as at 25 June 2016
4. **All events will be swum as timed finals**
5. Swimming up an age is permitted in all events **EXCEPT** 1, 14 & 15, which must have actual age group swimmers
6. Swimmers may swim in both age group and open events
7. Super 5 & Flying Squadron age groups are 9/under, 10/11, 12/13, 14/15, 16/over
8. **Flying Squadron (Event 23) swimming order must be youngest first to oldest last. Females start end, males turn end**
9. **Clubs may enter more than one team in aged relay events**
10. All Clubs should have a team manager present at the marshalling area to assist with identification of teams
11. **The age for the Golden Oldies is not less than 30 years. No other restrictions apply**
12. **All relay events must have submitted names and times when entries are made. Any changes for events to relays, must be submitted by 12 [noon] on Friday 24th June 2016, to Bridget at Events@swimwn.co.nz**
13. **Direct substitutions for team members affected by illness may be made up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet.** Failure to swim in the named order will result in disqualification of the team
14. **All entries are to be submitted online via the SNZ online portal by the Club Administrator/Race Secretary**
15. **Entries close on Sunday 19 June at 23:59:59 – late entries will not be accepted**
16. **Entry fees will be \$25.00 per team per event, the Golden Oldies will be free**
17. **Clubs will be invoiced for the entry fees of \$25 per team, and must be paid by Thursday 23rd June 2016.** Direct bank deposit or Electronic payments can be made to; **WPT 030502-0166158-00**. The conditions of this meet are that all entry fees are to be paid in advance
18. **There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the circulation of psych sheets on Monday 20th June 2016**
19. Pool door fees are payable on entry as \$2.00 per spectator, Programmes will be \$2.00
20. Officials and Coach/Managers at a ratio of 1 per 4 Club Teams will be free on sign in at the door
21. Medals for places 1-3 inclusive will be presented at the end of the meet, along with the Event Trophies. All team members will be expected to attend the presentation. **Current trophy holders are to ensure that the trophies are cleaned, engraved and returned to Bridget Tait by Thursday 23rd June 2016, at Pelorus House, 93 Hutt Park Road, Seaview**
22. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules
23. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under the IPC Swimming Rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of the meet
24. By entering this event swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swim Wellington in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy
25. Swimming Wellington reserves the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme
26. All swimmers entering this meet must provide an official or person to assist with running the meet as required. A request for key officials and timekeepers will be sent shortly by Greg Forsythe
27. Swimming Wellington will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet
