## Meet Conditions

1. This event will be swum Short Course and the start end will be from the shallow end. Please note the pool depth is 1.2m. Care is required when diving. Entry to the pool during warm-up will be feet first only (except authorised sprint lanes).
2. The meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA rules, with over the top starts.
3. Self-marshalling will operate.
4. A Team Managers Meeting will be held 10 minutes prior the start of the meet.
5. Age is at 6<sup>th</sup> May 2017. Open to SNZ registered competitive swimmers.
6. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under the IPC Swimming rules and must present their classification card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of the meet.
7. Entries are restricted to 3 events per swimmer.
8. Racing ages: 10 & U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17+.
9. Points allocations:
  - a. 10 & U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16 17+ (50s & 100s).
  - b. 12 & Under, 13 & Over (200/400s).
10. Points: 20, 14, 10, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 (1-10 placings) per meet. Clubs scoring highest points on the night will be noted and the trophy will go to the Club with the highest points in January annually.
11. Participating Clubs can earn additional points through Club support of each Signature Meet.  
4-12 swimmers = 10 Points; 13-20 swimmers = 15 Points; 20-30 Swimmers = 20 Points; 31+ swimmers = 25 Points
12. Maximum meet length (3.5 hours – includes 25min warm up).
13. Entries will be via the SNZ Database. Entries close at 23:59.59 (midnight) on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April.
14. Entry fees are \$10.00 per event, payment online by Credit Card.
15. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the entries close on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April.
16. All scratchings will close by midday on the Friday prior to the start of the meet.
17. 1 NT for 100, 200 or 400m event only. No NTs for 50m events.
18. Tawa Swimming Club is not GST Registered
19. Swimming Wellington pool entry passes are to be used by Officials, Swimmers, Coaches and Team Managers. Visiting clubs will be issued with temporary entry passes for the weekend. Entry and programmes for nominated Team Coaches & Team Managers will be; 1–10 Swimmers [2], 11-20 [4], 21-35+ [6].
20. Entry to Wellington Regional Aquatic Centre is via the Main Entrance. Please ensure you show your pass upon entry.
21. \$2 door entry fee must be paid by all spectators. Entry through the Main Entrance for all Spectators. Programmes \$2 per session
22. The Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
23. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the program if necessary, and to restrict entries
24. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swimming Wellington or host Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
