Swimmers who compete in three events will be eligible for one of the three cash prizes of \$50.00 to be drawn at the end of the meet.

Swimmers must be present at the draw to claim their prize.

There will be a fundraising raffle on sale which will be drawn on the night. Tickets \$2 each or 3 for \$5

Meet Conditions

1. This event will be swum Short Course. Starts will be from the bulkhead at the middle of the pool. Care must be taken when diving. Pool depth is 2.0m (at start end) and 1.2m (at turn end).
2. Entry to the pool during warm-up will be feet first only (except authorised sprint lanes). Warm-up procedures will be advised prior to the meet.
3. The meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA rules, with over the top starts.
4. Marshalling will operate.
5. A Team Managers' Meeting will be held at 4.30pm.
6. Age is at 12th May 2018. Open to SNZ registered club and competitive swimmers.
7. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under the IPC Swimming rules and must present their classification card to the Meet Referee prior to the commencement of the meet.
8. Entries are restricted to 3 events per swimmer.
9. Maximum meet length (4 hours – includes warm up).
10. Entries will be via the SNZ Database. Entries open on Monday 2nd April 2018 and close at 23:59.59 (midnight) on Saturday 5th May 2018.
11. Entry fees are \$10.00 per event; payment must be made at the time of entry via Swimming NZ online, using credit or debit card. Pay later is not an option for this meet. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the entries close on Saturday 5th May 2018. Tawa Swimming Club is GST Registered (GST # 55-223-386).
12. All scratchings will close by midday on the Friday prior to the start of the meet.
13. NTs are permitted.
14. Strapping on a swimmer is not permitted unless sighted by the Meet Director/or Meet Referee and supported by a Doctor/or Physio certificate prior to the start of the meet.
15. Entry to Wellington Regional Aquatic Centre is via the Main Entrance. Swimming Wellington pool entry passes are to be used by Officials, Swimmers, Coaches and Team Managers. Entry and programmes for nominated Team Coaches & Team Managers will be; 1–10 Swimmers [2], 11-20 [4], 21-35+ [6].
16. \$3 door entry fee must be paid by all spectators. Programmes \$2.
17. The Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
18. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the program if necessary, and to restrict entries.
19. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swimming Wellington or host Clubs in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy. Club photographers should seek prior approval from the Meet organiser prior to the start of the meet, as per the Swimming Wellington Photography Policy.
20. Clubs are requested to nominate at least two qualified IOTs and two timekeepers per club. Trainee IOTs will be accepted on a first come basis. Please send names of nominated officials to hugh.allan@xtra.co.nz by Sunday 6th May 2018.
