Conditions of Entry

- The meet is open to Tawa Swimming Club registered recreational, club and competitive swimmers. Priority of entry will be given to Squad swimmers.
- The meet will be swum under SNZ Policy 007 and local rules. Times will be entered into the SNZ database. This meet is considered a "Development" meet by SNZ. Under a change in SNZ policies (due to COVID), times from a Development meet are currently able to be used as qualifying times for regional and national meets.
- 3. Age is as at 12th March 2022.
- 4. NT (No Times) are accepted for all events. A maximum of four events may be entered.
- 5. The meet is short course and will be run as mixed timed finals, with over the top starts.
- 6. Entry fee is \$4.00 per event. Payment must be made online at the time of entry via FastLane (requires credit/debit card). In addition, usual pool entry is payable at the door.
- 7. Entries close at 8.00am on Wednesday 9th March 2022 or when entries reach 70 swimmers (or whatever limit may apply to gatherings under the current Alert Level).



- 8. Tawa Swimming Club reserves the right to cancel the meet, restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme. All scratchings will close by midday Friday 11th March 2022.
- 9. The organisers will if necessary alter the programme, refuse entries, and/or cut the meet short to allow the meet to finish on time.
- There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the psych sheets are published, with the exception noted in the COVID section below.
- 11. The meet will be marshalled. Marshalling will be beside the toddler pool.
- 12. By entering this meet swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by Tawa Swimming Club. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Tawa Swimming Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
- 13. All swimmers entering this meet must make available an official or person to assist with running the meet as required. The officials co-ordinator will email those parents/caregivers who are selected to assist at the meet.
- 14. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- 15. Tawa Swimming Club will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet.
- 16. The organisers reserve the right to change any aspect of the event to meet COVID-19 health restrictions in place at the time of the meet.

COVID-19 Requirements

- A condition of entry to this meet is to follow any Covid rules set by the venue. There may be restrictions on the use of facilities at the venue.
- Under the Red Traffic Light Alert level, there are restrictions in place regarding the number of people allowed into the venue. We will have reduced numbers of officials and timekeepers, and no spectators. Please note, if you are required to assist at the meet you will receive an email confirming this.
- 3. If you are unwell you must stay home no excuses! No one should be participating (or leaving home) if they are displaying symptoms of COVID-19, are awaiting test results, or if required to self-isolate. Everyone aged 12 years 3 months and older will be required to show their vaccination pass as a condition to entry.
- 4. Individuals will need to sign in using the NZ COVID Tracer app, or on the form that will be available at reception.
- Refunds will be issued if the meet is disrupted due to COVID-19 Alert Levels, or if a swimmer is unwell (refunds to be determined at the discretion of the meet organiser).
