Conditions of Entry

- 1. The meet is open to Tawa Swimming Club and PCA registered recreational, club and competitive swimmers, aged 12 years and under.
- The meet will be swum under SNZ Policy 007 and local rules. Times will be entered into the SNZ database. This meet is considered a "Development" meet by SNZ.
- 3. Age is as at 20th October 2022.
- 4. Swimmers may only enter events for which they have no time in the SNZ database. This meet is to enable swimmers to enter events for the Junior Festival in November. Swimmers do not need qualifying times for this festival, simply a time in the database. This meet is to facilitate swimmers to get an official time in an event so they can enter the Junior Festival.
- 5. A maximum of three events may be entered.
- 6. The meet is short course and will be run as mixed timed finals, with over the top starts.

- 7. Entry fee is a flat entry fee of \$5.00. Payment must be made online at the time of entry via FastLane (requires credit/debit card). *In addition, usual pool entry is payable at the door.*
- 8. Entries close at 11.59pm on Monday 17th October 2022.
- 9. Tawa Swimming Club reserves the right to cancel the meet, restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme.
- 10. There will be no refunds for withdrawals.
- 11. The meet will be marshalled. Marshalling will be beside the toddler pool.
- 12. By entering this meet swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by Tawa Swimming Club. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Tawa Swimming Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
- 13. All swimmers entering this meet must make available an official or person to assist with running the meet as required. The officials co-ordinator will email those parents/caregivers who are selected to assist at the meet.
- 14. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- 15. Tawa Swimming Club will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet.
- 16. The organisers reserve the right to change any aspect of the event to meet COVID-19 health restrictions in place at the time of the meet.

COVID-19 Requirements

- 1. If you are unwell please stay at home. No one should be participating in this meet if they are displaying symptoms of COVID-19, are awaiting test results, or if required to self-isolate.
- 2. A refund may be issued if a swimmer is unwell (refunds to be determined at the discretion of the meet organiser).
