Conditions of Entry

- The meet will be swum under SNZ Policy 007 and local rules. Times will be entered into the SNZ database. This meet is considered a "Development" meet by SNZ.
- 2. Whilst Club Chambs is a "Development Meet", Disqualifications ("DQs") will be recorded. If a swimmer is given a DQ for an event, the time that the swimmer gains will still be valid for uploading to SNZ as an official time, however the swimmer will not be placed in their event and will not be entitled to any points (with the exception of the 1 point for racing that event).
- Age is as at 18th May 2024. To be eligible to compete at the 2024 TSC Club Champs, you must be a financial member of Tawa Swimming Club as at 30 April 2024. The meet is open to Tawa Swimming Club registered recreational, club and competitive swimmers.
- 4. NT (No Times) are accepted for all events. There is no restriction on the number of events entered, but swimmers must only enter events in their age group.
- 5. Marshalling will be next to the toddler pool.
- 6. Pool entry will be payable at the door.
- All events will be swum as timed finals, with results contributing to the Age Groups points and/or the Cups and Trophies as listed on the website.
- 8. Please refer to the trophy list on the website to see which events are swum for age group trophies.
- 9. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.

- 10. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet.

- 11. Tawa Swimming Club reserves the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme.
- 12. Entries will be via the SNZ Database. Entries close at 11.59pm, Sunday 12th May 2024 late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary.
- 13. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swimming Wellington or host Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
- 14. All swimmers entering this meet must provide an official or person to assist with running the meet as required.
- Senior officials are asked to advise Lisa McPhail of their availability by Monday 13th May 2024.
- Tawa Swimming Club will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet.
- 17. Family relay must consist of 3 people from two generations, i.e 2 swimmers, 1 parent or 2 parents, 1 swimmer (25m each swimmer).
- 18. Strapping of muscles/joints is not permitted unless supported by a doctor or physio certificate and sighted by the Meet Referee prior to the start of the meet.
- 19. Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ Regulation 008.

Scoring System

Points will be awarded as follows: 1st place = 8 points, 2nd place = 5 points, 3rd place = 3 points, in the below age groups. Each swimmer who enters and races an event will receive 1 point (for participation) for that event regardless of their placing (even if they receive a DQ form).
