Meet Conditions:

This is a combination event – SZR interclub 'officiated' event for NZSC times and 'development' meet for SZR recreational swimmers.

Inter-club 'Officiated' meet conditions:

- 1. This 'Officiated 'meet is open to club and competitive swimmers.
- 2. The meet will be swum under SNZ, World Aquatics and local rules.

Development meet conditions:

- a. This 'development' meet is open to SZR Recreational swimmers.
- SZR recreational swimmers are invited to enter the SZR events 4,7,10, 13 and 15 only in the separate event on Fastlane. Any recreation swimmers entered any other races will be withdrawn.
- c. These events (4,7,10,13,&15) will not be officiated.

General meet conditions:

- 3. Timing will be Colorado timing system.
- 4. All events will be swum short course, as mixed races, raced slowest to fastest with over the top starts.
- The pool depth is 1.8m. Care is required when diving. Feet first entry during warmup. Diving is permitted in lanes 1 and 7, start end only, for the last 10 minutes of warm-up.
- 6. Age is at 3 August 2024. No times (NT) will be accepted.
- 7. Entries and payments will be via Fastlane. Entries close at 23:59.59 on Sunday 28 July 2024. Late entries will only be considered if capacity allows. Please email race@szr.co.nz for late entry consideration.
- 8. Entry fees are \$8 per race and a swimmer can enter a maximum of 4 races. Payment online Swimming NZ's Fastlane by Credit or Debit Card.
- All withdrawals close at 5pm Thursday 1st August, all withdrawals after that time will be made at the venue with the recorder by 30 minutes before the start time. On the day, please notify your team manager to arrange withdrawal of races.

- 11. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after entries close. Medical certificates will be considered if emailed to admin@szr.co.nz by 5pm Friday 2nd August.
- 12. Marshalling will be 3 rows of chairs in the paddling pool area.
- 13. Spectator programmes will be emailed to clubs and available online at <u>SZR's</u> <u>facebook page</u>. No spectator programmes available at the meet.
- 14. Programmes for nominated coaches & team managers will be; 1–10 swimmers, [2], 11-20 [3], 21+ [4].
- 15. SZR rostered duty preferences can be sent to <u>admin@szr.co.nz</u> no later than Thursday 1st August 2024. Otherwise, rostering will be done at club administrators' discretion.
- 16. Clubs may be asked to provide IOT's or timekeepers if required.
- 17. Strapping of muscles and joints is not permitted unless sighted and approved by the Technical Director prior to the meet, supported by a doctor's/physio's certificate.
- Protests may be submitted in accordance with SNZ Policy 008 (to the Technical Director in writing on the SNZ protest form by the team manager within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event). The protest must be accompanied with \$100 (cash).
- 19. The Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
- 20. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by SW or host Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
- 21. The Organisers reserve the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme.
- 22. There will be an officials meeting at 5.15pm.
