## Meet Conditions

1. The meet is open to **all registered club and competitive** swimmers only.
2. Event 7 (800 Free) is open to swimmers aged 11 and over. Swimmers without an 800m Freestyle time must have a 400m Freestyle time in the SNZ database.
3. The meet is being run according to SNZ, World Aquatics and local rules.
4. No Times are permitted. Age is at 7 September 2024.
5. Classified para swimmers (including those with provisional classification) are eligible to compete at this meet.
6. The pool depth is 2.4m. Care is required when diving. Feet first entry during warm-up. Diving is permitted in lanes 0 and 9, start end only, for the last 10 minutes of warm-up.
7. The meet is short course and will be run as mixed races, slowest to fastest, with over-the-top starts.
8. All times must be held on the SNZ database. Converted times are permissible.
9. Entries are via FastLane and **close at 23:59.59 (midnight) on Sunday 1 September 2024.**
10. Entry fee is **\$10.00 per event, limited to 5 events per swimmer.** Payment must be made at the time of entry via FastLane online (requires credit/debit card). Pirates Swim Team is not GST Registered.
11. **There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the entries close.**
12. Scratching by email close by 5pm on Thursday 5 September 2024, and thereafter at the pool with the recorder 45 minutes before the meet starts.
13. The organisers reserve the right to restrict entries, combine events or alter the programme.
14. The final programme will be sent to clubs and will be available on the Pirates website [www.pirates.org.nz](http://www.pirates.org.nz) on Friday 6 September 2024.
15. Clubs are required to provide **at least 1 IOT and 1 timekeeper.** Please send names to [officials@pirates.org.nz](mailto:officials@pirates.org.nz) no later than Monday 2 September 2024.
16. Strapping of muscles and joints is not permitted unless sighted and approved by the Technical Director prior to the meet, supported by a doctor's/physio's certificate.
17. Protests may be submitted in accordance with SNZ Policy 008 (to the referee in writing on the SNZ protest form by the team manager within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event). The protest must be accompanied with \$100 (cash).
18. The organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
19. By entering this meet swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Pirates Swim Club. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Pirates Swim Club in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.

## Spectator / Swimmer Information

20. Printed programmes will not be available for spectators at the venue. Programmes will be emailed to race secretaries and will be available on the Pirates websites [www.pirates.org.nz](http://www.pirates.org.nz) or, so please print your own and bring it with you.
21. Pool entry for spectators is a gold coin.
22. The meet will be self-marshalled

## Warm-up information

23. Feet first entry, all lanes, except dive lanes.
24. Lane 0 = Para lane (if required)
25. Lanes 3 to 9 = general swimming
26. Lane 2 = pace lane
27. Lanes 0, 1 8 & 9 = dive lanes (last 15 minutes of warm-up).
