- 1. This event is a designated Short Course officiated meet and will be swum under SNZ/World Aquatics and local rules, with over the top starts. Timing will be manual.
- 2. Open to SNZ registered Competitive & Club swimmers.
- 3. Pool depth at start is 2m. Care required when diving. Feet first entry to pool during warm-up (except authorised sprint lanes).
- 4. Classified Para swimmers (including those with provisional classification) are eligible to compete at this meet.
- 5. Event 6 (400m IM) & 10 (400m Free) is open to swimmers aged 11 and over.
- 6. A maximum of 4 events per swimmer (not including the club relay). No Times are permitted.
- 7. Events will be swum as mixed timed finals.
- 8. Entries will be via the SNZ Fastlane. Entries close 23:59.59 (midnight) on Sunday 13th July 2025.

- 9. Entry fees are \$8 per event, payment online by credit card. There is no GST component to entry fees.
- 10. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the entries close on Sunday 13th July 2025. Late entries will be considered.
- 11. Scratchings close at 5pm Thursday 17th July 2025, and thereafter at the pool with the recorder 45 minutes before the meet starts.
- 12. Initial psych sheet will be sent to participating clubs on Wednesday 16th July 2025 and the Program will be sent out 5pm Friday 18th July 2025.
- 13. Club relay teams will consist of 1 male and 1 female in each of the following four age groups 10/11, 12/13, 14/15, 16 and over. Swimmers can swim up.
- 14. Strapping on a swimmer is not permitted unless sighted by the meet Technical Director prior to the start of the meet and supported by a Doctor or Physio certificate.



- 15. The organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the sport's anti-doping rules.
- 16. The organisers reserve the right to amend the programme if necessary, and to restrict entries
- 17. Disqualifications will be announced and can be viewed/photographed at the recorders desk.
- 18. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by the Masterton Swimming Club. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
- 19. Each club is required to supply Timekeepers & Qualified IOTs: please email names and roles to Tania Lindop. <u>tanialindop@yahoo.com.au</u> by 5pm Wednesday 16th July 2025.
- 20. There will be an officials meeting 20 minutes before the start of the meet
- 21. Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ policy 008 along with \$100 cash.
- 22. Doors will be open from 2.10pm for swimmers and spectators.

23. Warm-up information

- Feet first entry, all lanes, except dive lanes
- Lanes 1 to 6 = general swimming
- Lane 2 = Designated Pace Lane
- Lane 7 = is available for Para-Swimmers lane (if required, opens up for dive lane last 15mins of warmup)
- Lanes 1 & 7 = dive lanes (last 15 minutes of warm-up).
- 24. Marshalling this event will be self-marshalled with entry via the far end of the pool. We will have an usher there to assist the younger swimmers.
