Meet Set Up

Meet will be swum short course under SNZ/World Aquatics rules except where local rules and conditions apply. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under WPS swimming rules.

All events will be swum as single age timed finals with over the top starts.

This will be a marshalled event.

Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ policy 008 along with \$100 cash.

All events (except relays) will be swum oldest to youngest, fastest to slowest and scored in the following age groups for both male & female:

50m & 100IM events: 12, 11, 10 & 9/U years

Relays

4 x 50m Mixed Medley Relay: Maximum of 3 teams per club, 12 and under mixed - 2 boys and 2 girls. Swimmers must be entered in individual events to be entered in relays.

Relay entries must be emailed to the Events Manager events@swimwn.co.nz by 9am Thursday 24th July 2025.

Awards

Wellington Swimmers - The top 3 Wellington swimmers placing in each event will receive a Gold, Silver or Bronze medal.

Visitors - a maximum of 2 visitor medals will be awarded in any one event.

Ribbons

will be available for collection for swimmers finishing in the top 10 who did not receive a medal. No medals or ribbons for relay event. Medals will be presented at the end of the meet. Club uniform tops for medal presentations. Same gender substitutes permitted. Age group points will be earned as 20, 14, 10, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for first to tenth inclusive. Trophies will be awarded to Wellington Regional Clubs only:- **The Eyeline Cup** - for the highest scoring Wellington Club in the 12&U age. Does not include relay event. **SW Junior Sprint Relay Cup** - for fastest time recorded by a Wellington Club in the Relay Event 41. **SW Junior Sprint Challenge Swim Cap** - for the highest scoring Swimming Wellington boy & girl of each age group - 9/u, 10, 11 & 12. Age group points are earned from the 50m free, breast, fly and back. .

Warm-Up

Warm-up duration: 25 minutes

Lanes 1-9: General Swimming with only feet first entry applicable in all lanes.

Lanes 0/1 & 8/9: To become dive lanes at 4.15pm.

Lane 2: designated pace lane

Lane 0: General swimming (unless required by para swimmers) between 4.00 – 4.15pm.

Conditions of Entry

1. This meet is open to financial SNZ registered competitive and club swimmers aged 12 years and under. Overseas competitors may compete subject to providing a signed Travel Form/Letter from their national federation.
2. Age as at 26th July 2025. NT are allowed.
3. Entries open at 8:00am on Monday 30 June 2025, closing at midday on Monday 21 July. Entries and payment will be via the SNZ Database only. Late entries and changes to events entered may be accepted until 5:00pm Tuesday 22 July on payment of a \$50 late fee as well as the relevant entry fee/s. No entries will be accepted after late entries close.
4. Entry fees are \$12.00 per event per swimmer. Except for Relays - there is no cost.
5. Swimming Wellington reserves the right to restrict entries and amend the programme and will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet.
6. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after entries close.
7. Withdrawals before the meet can be emailed to events@swimwn.co.nz by 5pm Thursday 24 July 2025. Withdrawals after this time are to be via a withdrawal form at the recorder's desk at the venue 45 minutes before the start of the meet.
8. All Participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
9. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington or host Clubs in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.
10. Strapping of muscles/joints is not permitted unless supported by a doctor or physio certificate and sighted by the Technical Director prior to the first session the strapping is applied.

Officials information

1. All participating Swimming Wellington clubs are required to provide officials for this meet. RTOP will send this request to clubs.
2. Qualified visiting officials are welcome and may apply via email RTOP@swimwn.co.nz. All qualified officials are required to have a current SNZ police vet recorded on the SNZ database.
3. Officials to bring their own water bottles. There will be an officials meeting 20 minutes prior to the start of the meet, 4.15pm.

Club & Spectator Information

1. A seating plan will be published on the SW website on Wednesday 23rd July 2025.
2. Entry fee is \$3.00 for spectators 16 years and over.
3. The Swimming NZ Code of Conduct and Media and Photography position statement in the Swimming NZ Member Protection Policy Manual apply to all competitors, volunteers and spectators entering CAC. The Manual can be found on the Swimming NZ website.
4. Initial psych sheets will be posted on the website on same day of entry close and finalised programme on Friday 25th July 2025.
5. Programmes will be available online on the Swimming Wellington website by Friday 25 July and on Meet Mobile.
6. Entry for all swimmers, officials, team managers and coaches will be via the main entrance at Coastlands Aquatic Centre. Coaches are to display their NZSCTA cards throughout the meet. Officials (including timekeepers and duty club volunteers are required to sign in on entry.)
7. Entry for nominated Team Coaches & Team Managers will be limited to the following numbers: - 1 - 10 swimmers - 1 coach & 2 team managers 11- 20 swimmers - 2 coaches & 3 team managers 21 - 35+ swimmers - 3 coaches & 4 team managers. Two (2) programmes for each club can be uplifted from the sign in desk on entry and will be available via wellingtonswimming.org.nz.
8. Disqualifications will be announced, and can be viewed / photographed at the recorders desk
9. All participating Swimming Wellington clubs are required to provide volunteers for marshalling, runner, and medals. Swimming Wellington will send a request to all clubs.
10. Visiting clubs - please provide names of team managers and coaches to events@swimwn.co.nz The meet will be on Meet Mobile - these are unofficial until the referee has signed them off.
11. There will be a team manager meeting 15 minutes before the start of warm-up, 3.45pm. location TBC.
12. The organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet.
